## Program Description

The McGregor Company scholarship program has been designed to provide graduating high school seniors with financial assistance to pursue their ag-related educational goals as they begin college.

Scholarships are one year in length and will be awarded in amounts up to \$1,000 per student. Award recipients will be notified in May 2026.

## Eligibility

- ✓ Must be a graduating high school senior in 2026 (public, private, charter, or home-school)
- ✓ Must plan to enroll at a college, university, or technical school within the United States as a full-time student
- ✓ Must reside within a reasonable distance of the customers we serve from McGregor branches in Washington, Idaho, and Oregon
- ✓ Must be enrolling in an agriculture-related field of study

- Resume with photograph** (*not to exceed 2 pages*)
- Copy of High School Transcript** (*NOTE: if you are selected for an award, we will require an official transcript at that time*)
- Two (2) Letters of Recommendation**
- Essay** (typed, not to exceed 600 words)
